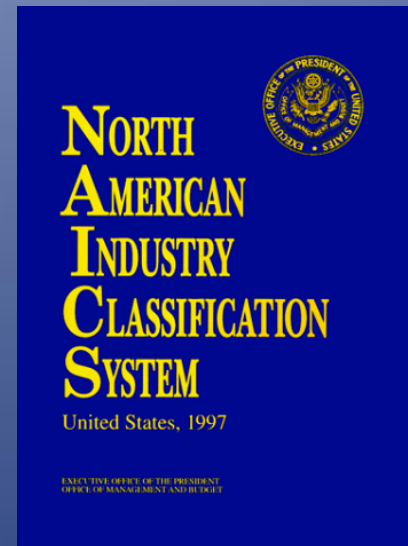

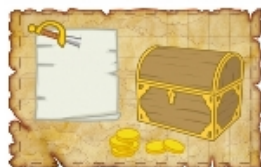
Finding Industry Codes

- ❑ Industry codes are useful when researching an industry
- ❑ 2 numbering systems used to identify industries
- ❑ NAICS (North American Industrial Classification) is the standard for U.S., Canada & Mexico
- ❑ SIC (Standard Industrial Classification) is the older of the two, gradually being phased out
- ❑ Find NAICS industry codes at the Census Bureau: NAICS site -- Use the keyword search box or the drill down chart
- ❑ Find SIC industry codes at the Department of Labor - Occupational Safety & Health Administration site
